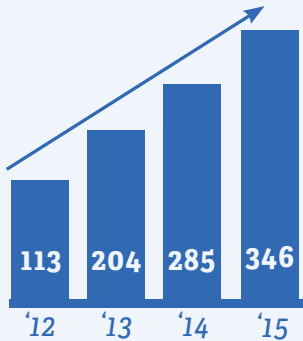


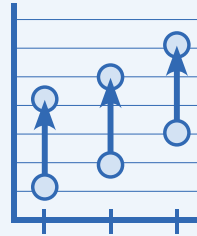
# Highlights of the 2015 report



The number of reports has **increased since 2012.**



Increased reporting is believed to **demonstrate an increased awareness** about the ARIR.

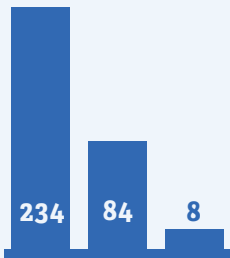


Despite the increase, the proportions of incidents in various categories **remain similar** from one year to the next.

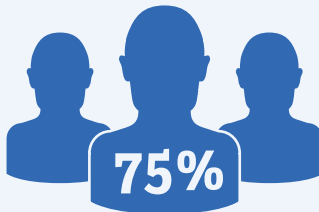


**95%**

The majority of incidents (95%) reported were **related to medical procedures.**



**Reported incidents:**  
Diagnostic radiology: **234**  
Nuclear medicine: **84**  
Radiotherapy: **8**



Most of these incidents were triggered by **human error** (75%).



**8%**

Only 8% of incidents were due to **malfunction of the medical equipment.**



Incidents have multiple contributing causes and tightening controls to reduce human errors may be enough to **prevent an incident.**
