Dear Import Permit Applicant,

Increase in Medical and Non-Medical Import Permit Fees Effective 1 July 2016.

ARPANSA's fees for Customs Prohibited Import Permits issued under the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* have increased in line with the adjustment to the Wage Price Index. The fee increase for the period commencing 1 July 2016 is 2.7% and is applied to import permits issued for both medical and non-medical radioisotopes.

The new fee schedule is:

Single Shipment Permit - Standard	\$164	\$168
Single Shipment Permit - Urgent	\$272	\$279
12 Month Permit	\$1894	\$1945
