at University of Melbourne

Thank you for your letter of 22 July. s 47F - privacy has advised us that s [Redacted] carried out a radiation survey in February and reported to you that the building is free of radioactive contamination (following his removal of a piece of contaminated wood) and there is no need to impose any radiological health restrictions on work in the building.

The Laboratory had carried out a complete survey following decontamination of the building and I am attaching a statement with respect to the radiological aspects of the building for your information. As s 47F - privacy has since carried out a comprehensive survey and s [Redacted] is satisfied that there are no radiological problems with the building, we agree with s [Redacted] that there is no need for a further radiation survey.

As advised in my letter of 20 July, arrangements have been made for minor repairs to be carried out and the premises to be cleaned. Accordingly, I believe the building is in a satisfactory condition and we have no further use for it. In finally vacating the building and handing it back to the University, I would like to express the appreciation of the Laboratory, its s 47F - privacy and the Commonwealth Department of Health for use of the building since its opening in 1938 and for the various services extended to the Laboratory by the University over the years.
